

Rules For The 34th Annual Guppy College Bowl Contest (2021-2022)

1) Contest begins with the Friday 12/17/21 game at Noon. There are 43 games to select. This contest is only for the **152** of you who paid \$10 for the Bowl games at the beginning of the Guppy season. The lines for the Bowl games are posted on the Office Pool website. **25 games must be played** or the prize money \$2,690 (\$1,170 from prior year plus \$1,520) will be rolled into the 2022-2023 contest.

2) Please be sure to use the **same “user” name** for the College Bowl Contest as the Regular Season Contest.

3) In order to select all 43 games, your entry is due by 11:55 AM on Friday December 17, 2021. However, you can change any selection of games not yet played at any time after Noon and prior to the scheduled start of any game until approximate kickoff of the January 10th Championship Game when your Championship Game selection and Total Points will be posted on Office Pool. **If you fail to select any game, you are given a “No Play” for the omitted game(s) but you will not be eliminated. Prizes are based on total wins not winning percentage.** You can select until approximate kickoff of the final game on January 10th (Championship Game). The Championship matchup will not be determined until after the December 31st semi-finals are played. **You can’t win the last place prize unless you have selected all 43 games.**

4)** The selection of one of four teams prior to the playing of the December 31st semi-finals to determine the Championship Game participants is just a “Placeholder.”** This is set up for those pools that want all selections made at the beginning of the selection process and this selection is used as a tiebreaker along with total points. **Once the semi-finals are played, in our contest, a point spread will be posted and you have until kickoff of the Championship Game to select the winner of the January 10th game with the point spread and also be allowed to change your total point selection.**

5) If you omit the total points for the Championship game, you can’t win any tiebreaker.

7) The tiebreaker is the total points in the Championship game to be played on January 10, 2022. Be sure to fill in the total points that you think will be scored in the game. You can go over the final total and win. **If you omit the total points, you can’t win a tiebreaker for any prize and please use whole numbers, not decimals.** If you do select a decimal, we will only use the whole number used with no rounding.

8) For 1st-5th place ties, the person **closest to the National Championship total points wins. For last place ties, the person **furthest** from the total points wins. To finish first, you need the most total wins. To finish last, you must have selected all 43 games for the total points to even matter.**

9) Prizes-1st \$1,000; 2nd \$500; 3rd \$375; 4th \$315; 5th \$200; Last-\$125. Expenses are \$175. There were 152 entrants for the 2021-22 season at \$10 per entrant (\$1,520) plus \$1,170 carried over from the 2020-2021 season when less than 25 Bowl games were played. As a result, total prize money is \$2,690

10) Prize money will be mailed on January 29, 2022.
